



Simple Newborn Boots

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Caron simply soft – 2 Colors
F hook
Yarn Needle

1.

Worked in the round: Ch 9. 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Sc 3. Hdc. Dc 2. Dc 7 in last ch.
Working across the other side, dc 2. Hdc, sc 3.

2.

Hdc 2 in the next 3 sts. Hdc 7. Hdc 2 in the next 5 sts. Hdc 7.

3. -4.

sc in each st around, 30 sc.

5.

sc 13. Dc2tog 6 times. Sc 5.

6.

sc 13. Dc2tog 3 times. Sc 6.

7.

sc 13. Hdc2tog twice. Sc 4

8. -9.

Sc in each st around.

10.

sc 12. Sc2tog. Sc 6.

11-16.

work one sc in each st around.

17.

(Sc2tog, sc in next st) all around.

Bow:

Start with a tail.
Ch 5.

1.

Sc in 2nd ch from hook. Sc 3. Turn.

2. -3.

Ch 1. Sc in same st. Sc 3. Turn.

4.

ch 1. Sc2tog twice. Turn.

5.

Sc 2

6.

ch 1. Sc 2 in same st. Sc 2 in last st. turn

7. - 9.

ch 1, sc in same st. Sc 3.

Tie off. Leave a tail.

Using the tails and a yarn needle, sew the bow onto the top toe of the boots (or wherever you want them). You could also weave in the tails, and attach the bow using a small amount of hot glue.
