



## Wonderland Blocks

These blocks make a sweet toy for baby. Light enough to be stacked or thrown, these soft playthings are safe for little ones and add charm to any nursery. Place a jingle bell or sound maker in the interior for a playful noisemaker!



## Materials

- Malabrigo Rios worsted weight 100% superwash merino wool yarn (3.5 oz/210 yds/100g per hank): 1 skein in Niebla RIO122, 1 skein in Natural RIO063
- Hook: size (L-11) 8 mm
- #7 plastic canvas; six 3 x 3 inch squares

## Pattern info

- Gauge: 6 rows and 5 sts = 2" in sc
- Skill level: beginner
- Necessary skills: basic sts, working in rows
- Finished size: 3.5" cube

## Abbreviations

[ ] . . . . . work instructions within brackets as many times as directed

() . . . . . used for additional or clarifying information.

ch—chain

rep— repeat

sl st— slip stitch

sp(s)—space(s)

st(s)— stitch(es)

xs— times



# Pattern

Square 1 (make 2)

With 3 strands of Natural held together, ch 10.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook and in each ch across. (9 sc)

Row 2 – 10: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Finish off.

Square 2 (make 2):

With 3 strands of Niebla held together rep square 1 instructions.

Square 3 (make 2):

With 1 strand of Niebla and 2 strands of Natural held together, rep square 1 instructions.

Sewing together:

Sew plastic canvas together to form a block.

Sew squares together with same squares sewn on the opposite side of the block.
