Crochet Key Fob

Abbreviations: (American Terms)

Ch – [chain](#)
Sc – [single crochet](#)
Sl st – [Slip Stitch](#)
St – [stitch](#)

What you need: ([affiliate links](#))

-Medium Weight Yarn (I used a color mix of [Comfy Worsted](#) and [Shine Worsted](#) by [Knit Picks](#), both are cotton blends)
-[G Hook](#)
-[Metal Key Hooks](#)

Gauge is not important

Ch 40.

Slip the end of your chain through the bottom of the key ring. Sl st into the first ch, forming a loop (take care not to twist the ch. **(Photo 1)**)

1. Ch 1. Sc in same st. Sc 39. Join with sl st. (40 sts) **(Photo 2)**

2. Ch 1. Sc in same st. Sc 39. Join with sl st. (40 sts)

3. Ch 1. Sc in same st. Sc 39. Join with sl st. (40 sts).

If your first color is your accent color and bottom layer, don't break the yarn. Using your second color, ch 40. Pull the end through the key ring and join with first ch, forming a loop.

(Photo 3) Repeat rows 1-3. You will have 2 layers on your key ring. **(Photo 4)**

Position the two layers so right sides are facing outward and line them up. Then, taking the loop from your first layer, pull it through the 2nd layer and slip st them together across the side. **(Photo 5)**

Tie off and weave in end. Using same color yarn, slip stitch around the bottom. (for ease, I stuffed most of the loose ends in between so I didn't need to weave them in). **(Photo 6) (Photo 7)**

To finish, using two strands of yarn on your darning needle and sew a line below the key ring, securing it at the end. **(Photo 8)**

Find the middle of one side of the pouch.
Join 2nd color yarn, working from the outside

Make a chain about 35" long. Sc in 3rd ch from hook. Sc in each ch. Sl st into the same st you started. Clip ends and tie off.

Simple Wrap Clutch

Abbreviations: (American Terms)

Ch – [chain](#)
Sc – [single crochet](#)
Sl st – [Slip Stitch](#)
St – [stitch](#)

What you need: ([affiliate links](#))

- 330 Yards of Medium Weight Yarn (3 balls of [Comfy Worsted](#) plus extra for the tie (in a contrasting color)
- G Hook

Gauge: Work as many chs you need to make your foundation 8 1/4" long OR use a hook that makes your foundation of 37 chains 8 1/4" long.

Ch 37 (about 8 1/4" long)

1. Sc in 2nd ch from hook. Sc in each remaining chain. (36 sts)
2. - 90. Ch 1. Sc in each st across. (36 sts)

Fold bottom up, so the piece is in half. Sl st down the side sewing the two layers together. Tie off.

Take a length of yarn and sl st up the





Faded Stripes Slouchy

BLO - Back Loops Only

What you need: ([affiliate links](#))

- Medium Weight yarn in 2 color

- G Hook

Gauge: See step 5

Note: Ch 1 doesn't count. Always work 1st st in same st as chain, and join with the first st of the round, not the chain.

With 1st color: magic ring

1. Ch 2. Dc 12 into ring (12 sts)

2. Ch 2. 2 dc in each st around (24 sts)

3. Ch 2. *Dc. 2 dc in next st* repeat 12 times. (36 sts)

4. Ch 2. *Dc 2. 2 dc in next st.* work 12 times. (48 sts)

5. Ch 2. *Dc 3. 2 dc in next st* work 12 times. (60 sts)

Gauge Checkpoint: approx. 5" diameter

6. Ch 2. *Dc 4. 2 dc in next st* work 12 times. (72 sts)

7. Ch 2. Dc 9. 2 dc in next st* work 8 times. (80 sts) (Should be 6 3/4 " here, when you stop increasing)

8. Ch 2. Dc in each st around. (80 sts)

Join 2nd color.

9. Ch 1. Sc in each st around. Join with sl st. (80 sts)

Bring up 1st color.

10. Ch 2. Dc in each st around. Join with sl st. (80 sts)

11. Ch 1. Hdc in each st around. Join with sl st (80 st)
Bring up 2nd color

12. Ch 1. Hdc in each st around. Join with sl st. (80 sts)

Bring up 1st color.

13. Ch 2. Dc in each st around. Join with sl st. (80 sts)
Bring up 2nd color

14. Ch 2. Dc in each st around. Join with sl st (80 sts)
Bring up 1st color

15. Ch 1. Hdc in each st around. Join with sl st. (80 sts)

Bring up 2nd color

16. Ch 1. Hdc in each st around. Join with sl st. (80 sts)

17. Ch 2. Dc in each st around. Join with sl st (80 sts)

Bring up 1st color.

18. Ch 1. Sc in each st around. Join with sl st. (80 sts)

Bring up 2nd color.

19. - 22. Ch 2. Dc in each st around. Join with sl st. (80 sts)

23. - 25. Ch 1. Sc in BLO in each st around. Join with sl st. (80 sts)

Note: To make your hat more slouchy, work a few ore rows of dc stitches before working the sc BLO rows.
